Additional Wider Achievement and Pupil Leadership Opportunities

In addition to the clubs and activities detailed in this booklet, pupils will have the opportunity to participate in other wider achievement and pupil leadership opportunities which develop a range of skills for learning, life and work.

S1

- All S1 pupils are currently participating in the **Right Here, Right Now Challenge**. The challenge aims to develop pupil's knowledge and understanding of children's rights in a way which is personalised to suit their own interests (this was launched in September 2025).
- Our **P7 Transition Ambassador Programme** will provide S1 pupils with the opportunity to support a range of events linked to the P7 Transition 'Destination: Douglas' (this will be launched with pupils in November 2025).
- All S1 pupils are encouraged to participate in volunteering in school and outside of school. These volunteering hours can be recognised and celebrated through the achievement of a **Saltire Award**.

S2

- All S2 pupils will participate in the **Youth and Philanthropy Initiative (YPI)** which empowers young people to make a difference in their communities by raising awareness of social issues and local charities (this will be launched with pupils in January 2026).
- All S2 pupils are encouraged to participate in volunteering in school and outside of school. These volunteering hours can be recognised and celebrated through the achievement of a **Saltire Award**.

S3

- S3 Pupils will have the opportunity to participate in the Outward Bound Adventure and Challenge Award at Loch Eil Outdoor Education Centre (This will be launched with pupils in September 2025).
- S3 pupils will have the opportunity to participate in our **Bronze Duke of Edinburgh Award Programme**. This award allows pupils to take part in a range of activities, leading to the achievement of an award that is recognised by universities and employers, as well as enabling pupils to develop new and existing skills by participating in enjoyable experiences (this will be launched with pupils in January/February 2026).

- All S3 pupil will have the opportunity to participate in the **S3 Stock Market Challenge**. This opportunity allows the young people to engage in the world of economics, investing and personal finance with the Business and Maths Department.
- All S3 pupils are encouraged to participate in volunteering in school and outside of school. These volunteering hours can be recognised and celebrated through the achievement of a **Saltire Award**.
